

LENNAR FLAGPOLE POLICY

Adopted 2-22-2024

Types of flags permitted:

- The flag of the United States of America
- The flag of the state of Idaho displayed in accordance with 4 U.S.C. 5 et seq.
- The POW/MIA flag
- An official or replica flag of any branch of the United States Armed Forces
- An official or replica flag representing a first responder (EMS, Nurse, Firefighter, Police, Military, Corrections, Dispatch)

Flags not described as above, or any flag with vulgar language, will not be permitted. Any displayed flag and the flagpole on which it is flown are to be maintained in good condition. The association will require any deteriorated flag, or deteriorated or structurally unsafe flagpole, be repaired, replaced, or removed.

INSTALLATION GUIDELINES

Exposed Pole Height:	20' Maximum (1Story) or 25' Maximum (2 Story)
Diameter:	No less than 3" in Diameter
American Flag Size:	No less than 3'x5', no more than 4'x6'
Material:	Aluminum
Flagpole Finish:	Aluminum (Clear or Black/Rubbed Bronze)
Position in the Front Yard:	Must provide a detailed drawing location and must be approved by the ACC.
Must accommodate wind speed:	Minimum of 70mph
Concrete Footing:	Minimum of 14" Round. Not built up above the ground.
For Non-Telescoping Poles (Halyard):	Internal or External permitted

**Telescoping Flagpole and Solar Flagpole Light (Similar to the Titan Telescoping Flagpole) if meeting above conditions may be approved by the ACC when appropriate paperwork is submitted for approval.
